Water Tank Recoating Project—Grant

The Stratmoor Hills Water District was recently awarded a grant in the amount of \$700,000 for a Water Tank Recoating Project scheduled to be completed in the Fall of 2025.

The grant will be administered by the Colorado Department of Local Affairs (DOLA) as part of the Energy/Mineral Impact Assistance Fund (EIAF) program. Our project was reviewed based on a variety of factors such as its connection to energy impact, degree of need, measurable outcomes, amount of request, relationship to community goals, level of local match and community support, management capacity, resiliency and readiness to go. These grant funds will be from federal mineral lease proceeds.

The total cost for the water tank recoating project is estimated at 1.4 million dollars. The district will rely on existing reserves to pay for one half of the cost of the project. The project will involve sandblasting and recoating both the interior and exterior of the dis-

trict's 2.5 million gallon water tank located at Academy and Venetucci Blvd., near Wal-Mart.

The grant will benefit our customers by eliminating the need to finance the project, which would likely lead to a rate increase to cover the costs of the loan.

The Water Tank Recoating project is one of several capital projects needed to keep our system running reliable and efficient.
