Know What's Below

Summer is a great time to complete outdoor projects. If you're digging deep or even just a few inches, you must contact Colorado 811 to have underground utilities marked. Colorado 811 works with Stratmoor Hills Water and Sanitation districts, along with other facility owners to make certain we are notified of any digging activity planned in our service area. Our operators will respond within 72 hours.

It is important to call 811 before you dig, so you can avoid hitting any underground utilities, such as cables, wire or pipes. It is also the law to contact 811 before you dig.

You can start digging once all your markings are in place, or you receive a positive response from the utilities on your ticket.

Homeowners and Professional Excavators can call 811, or go to the Colorado 811 website at www.colorado811.org to request a locate. Please note: it is necessary to Call 811 directly to report Emergency and Damage tickets.

SUMMER WATERING TIPS

- Adjust sprinklers to prevent water from spraying on non-landscaped areas including the sidewalk or street.
- Water in the morning or late evening when temperatures are cooler to minimize evaporation.
- If water runs off of your lawn easily, split your watering times into shorter periods to allow for better absorption.




